

Our Parish Project

The parish project committee is pleased to confirm that we have finalised the process and timetable for our Parish vote to decide where we should build our new church. The following details are provided for your information. Please take time to review the material to ensure you have the opportunity to have your say.

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible to submit ONE vote to stay at Seaford OR move to Carrum Downs you need to be:

- (a) A current Parishioner family;**
- (b) A family with one or more children currently registered at St Anne’s School; or**
- (c) A family with one or more children registered at St Joachim’s School.**

A maximum of ONE vote is available PER eligible family; each family eligible to vote must be listed on the ‘Eligible Families Register’.

Important! Current Parishioners who attend mass but are not on any of the above registers will need to ENROL if they wish to vote.

3. <u>Pre and Post voting</u> There is the opportunity to either pre or post VOTE at the Parish Office ONLY if you will be away during voting week. 4. <u>Schools and Parish voting</u> Voters attend in person at their child’s or children’s school to receive their BALLOT forms and lodge their vote immediately.
