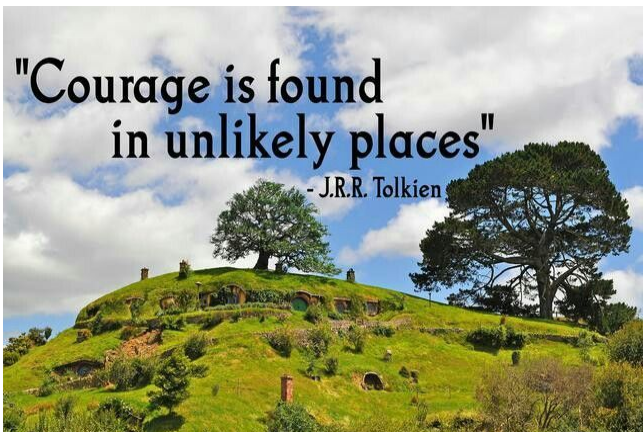
Next zoom meeting: Saturday, 23 May @ 7.30pm. Details will be sent out this week.
